 - 2. Set "username" to your email address such as email@yourdomain.com
 - 3. Set "password" to your password
- 12. Under "Outgoing mail server"
 - 1. Set "Host name" to mail.yourdomain.com (replacing "yourdomain.com" with your actual website domain name)
 - 2. Set "username" to your email address such as email@yourdomain.com
 - 3. Set password to your password
- 13. Tap "**Next**"
- 14. If a message shows that the iPhone cannot verify the server identity, tap "Continue"
- 15. Ensure Mail is "**On**"
- 16. Tap "**Save**"
- 17. Setup is now complete. Exit from settings by going to the home screen and tap your Mail icon to open your email program. You are now ready to send and receive emails via your iPhone.
